Proclamation

WHEREAS, on June 17, 2005 The Nike Outdoor Sprint Medley Relay Nationals were held in Greensborough, North Carolina; and

WHEREAS, the team members that participated at the Nationals were Marvin Carter, Freddie Mendenhall Jr., Daniel Millan, Rob Novak and Michael Steffen; and the coaches that attended were Head Coach, Charles Miller and the Assistant Coach, Tony Haneman; and the Team Manager was Colin Batchelor; and

WHEREAS, during the 4x400M Medley Steffen, Millan, Mendenhall and Novak came in 2nd in Heat and 10th Overall and they placed first in the Sprint Medley becoming the National Champions with the fastest time run since 2002; and

WHEREAS, during the Sprint Medley Relay, Rob Novak's 1.48.6 split brought Bordentown Regional High School from sixth to first place on the anchor leg as the New Jersey squad went on to win in 3:24.19; and

WHEREAS, the Sprint Medley Relay, (S.M.R.), consists of a pair of 200m legs, followed by a 400 and an 800m. Mike Steffen opened for Bordentown, followed by Dan Millan and Freddie Mendenhall Jr.; and

WHEREAS, these fine athletes have been recognized for their stellar athletic achievements by being nominated then formally inducted into the Hall of Fame on April 27, 2019 at the Bordentown Elks Lodge#205 at 3:00p.m.
