PSE&G is in the process of making repairs to its natural gas facilities on Rt. 130 in Brooklawn between the Brooklawn Circle and Browning Road. All of the work will be done in the north-bound lanes. The repairs are being done as a result of required surveys in that area.


Please note that the area inside your home or business and around your property has been deemed safe. PSE&G personnel will continue to monitor the area to ensure the safety of all the residents of Brooklawn.

The repairs are scheduled to begin on or about Friday, October 3, 2014, and are expected to take two weeks to complete. Crews will work around the clock --seven days a week until completed. PSE&G is asking for your patience and cooperation while we complete the project.

PSE&G has spoken with both municipal and state officials, and will have Brooklawn Police on site throughout the project to direct traffic. We will make every effort to minimize the work area. Although the roadway will remain open in both directions, it will be necessary to close the right lane and right shoulder during construction.

PSE&G would like to thank you in advance for allowing us to provide you with safe, reliable, clean, economical natural gas, and for your cooperation in this matter.
