Attention Residents,

The following information is being provided to better service you. Help us reduce incinerator fees by recycling. Recycling cans are available. If you have not received one, call us at 856-456-2638 Or 856-456-0750 to request one. One can per household

MONDAY 1st and 3rd Monday Entire town.

Collection will include: **METALS**- such as posts with no concrete. White goods- such as washers, dryers, refrigerators, and air conditioners. **ELECTRONICS** including, computer products, toasters, microwaves, vacuum cleaners, Televisions etc. **WOOD**- such as tree limbs cut and tied in five-foot lengths, unpainted wood products, **CONCRETE** – to be placed at the curb in not larger than 12” blocks. ANY POSTS THAT HAVE BEEN SET IN CONCRETE MUST BE REMOVED FROM CONCRETE PRIOR TO PLACING AT CURB. IF CONCRETE IS NOT REMOVED POSTS WILL BE LEFT AT CURB SIDE

NO PRESSURE TREATED WOOD.

Please **DO NOT** put trash in with your vegetation or use plastic bags
We cannot pick it up.

During the summer months we will collect vegetation, bushes, tree limbs and unpainted wood every Monday. This will be done May through August.

TRASH & RECYCLING COLLECTION WILL COMMENCE AS FOLLOWS

TUESDAY East side of town only Regular household trash, grass clippings.

WEDNESDAY East and West side. Recycling

Recycling will include – Junk mail, newspapers, cardboard, magazines,
Plastic bottles, aluminum and steel cans, glass containers.

THURSDAY West side of town only Regular house hold trash, grass clippings.

Grass clippings placed in cans not to exceed 50 pounds.

Please notice,

Any painted and or stained wood should be placed at the curb on your regular trash day.

All items will be collected from the curb line and should be placed no earlier than 4:00pm on the day before your scheduled day. All emptied containers should be removed from the curb line 6:00pm the day of collections.

CLOTHING COLLECTION

Clothing bags for recycling will be collected the second Monday of the month. Place the yellow bags at the curb and the public Works Department will pick them up.

TRASH and **RECYCLABLE** materials mixed together WILL NOT be collected until separated. It will then be picked up on the next scheduled day.

The landfill or the incinerator will not accept **ROOF SHINGLES** OR TIRES. There fore it will be the responsibility of the contractor or the homeowner to dispose of them properly.

3YD DUMPSTERS

Dumpsters are available for residential use. **Not for a hired contractors.**

Items allowed in our dumpsters are: Household cleanouts, yard waste and wood items not exceeding 4 ft in length. **No construction materials allowed.**

ITEMS NOT ALLOWED IN DUMPSTERS -- Metals, concrete, Roofing materials

HOLIDAY TRASH & RECYCLING COLLECTIONS

Holiday **Pick up day**

If the Holiday falls on this day:

It will be collected on this day:

MONDAY	-----	TUESDAY
TUESDAY	-----	THE MONDAY BEFORE
WEDNESDAY	-----	THURSDAY
THURSDAY	-----	FRIDAY
FRIDAY	-----	THE THURSDAY BEFORE

The **exception** would be the **Thanksgiving Holiday** where the Public Works Department is closed Thursday and Friday, in that case trash will be collected on Wednesday along with recycling. Holiday schedules are always printed in the Gloucester City News one week in advance. Trash containers over 50 pounds **will not** be collected.

LEAF SEASON begins on November 1st and ends on December 20th. All leaves should be raked to the curb and not put into the street. Do not rake leaves onto or within 10 ft of a storm drain, this violates the Federal Storm Water regulations that could impose fine.

LEAVES will be collected in the following manor:

East side -- Mondays

West side -- Fridays

If time permits we will pick up leaves on any day starting where we left off the last day out.
