RE: KNOW WHERE WE STAND—Woodbine Bike Lanes

Residents know that the new bike lanes and traffic plan on Woodbine Ave need work.

The reduction of road volume has slowed traffic and TTC vehicles. It has also forced vehicles onto the neighbouring side streets. Having knocked on over 50,000 doors already, I know the Woodbine bike lanes are a critical issue and as a driver and an avid cyclist, I know the Woodbine bike lanes could be safer and work better for everyone.

What I want is new consultation and an expanded conversation on the existing bike lanes with local residents who know the problems and can provide solutions. This is about safety and mobility for drivers, pedestrians and cyclists. By coming together, we can make Woodbine work better for all of us.

Some candidates will say they will just take the bike lanes out but I will tell you clearly and honestly that this is not going to happen. The truth is that the bike lanes are part of Toronto's 10-Year Cycling Network Plan and there is no political path to getting these bike lanes removed. We have to come up with a better solution and move forward.

I will improve the existing traffic measures with a better, safer and more permanent one approved by you who are affected. **That is my written commitment and promise.**
