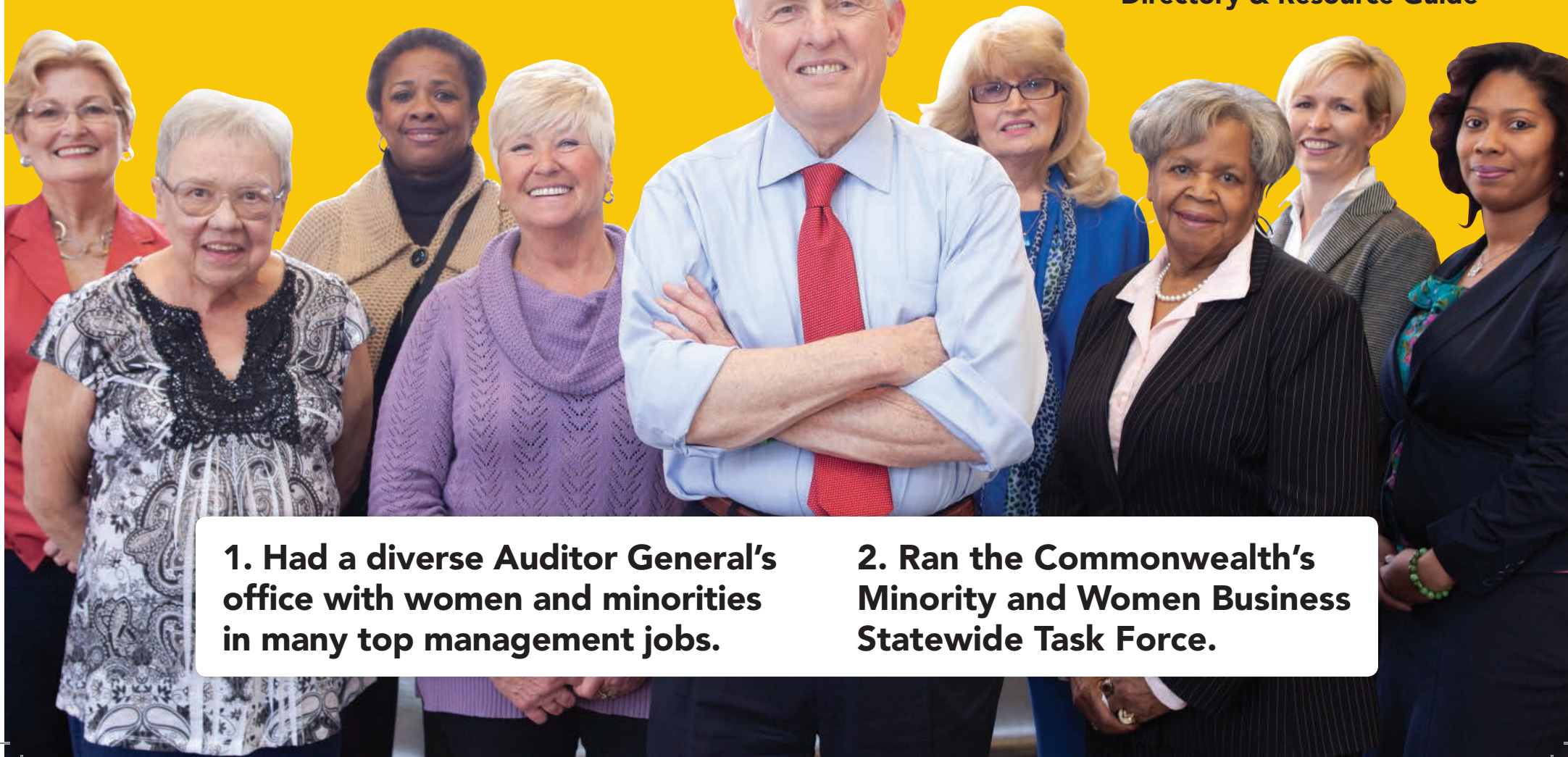


Jack Wagner has always fought for the inclusion of everyone in government.
