ARJ Civic raises its annual budget primarily through community-based fundraising activities, including an annual golf outing, corporate sponsorship opportunities, and donations.

ARJ Civic often partners with other community-based organizations, local corporations and elected officials in Newark, which allows the organization to expand the number of people who can be served.

In 2017, ARJ Civic partnered with the Hispanic Law Enforcement Society of Essex County, the Newark

Charter School Fund, The North Ward Center, the Newark Fire Union, and many other organizations.

The 2017 ARJ Civic Scholarship Awardees

The Anibal Ramos Jr. Civic Association has provided financial assistance to more than 100 students since its inception through scholarships, pageant sponsorships, and summer camps. ARJ Civic held an awards breakfast on July 20 at The North Ward Center to honor 11 high school and college honorees from Newark.

Since he was elected in 2006 as councilman representing the North Ward of Newark, Councilman Ramos has been awarding scholarships

to Newark students. ARJ Civic was formed as a non-profit organization a few years ago to accept donations from supporters who want to support scholarships for students.

Ramos, who grew up in Newark, attended Our Lady of Good Counsel High School. At the time, his mother began working part-time to pay the tuition. But she became ill, when he was a sophomore and could no longer work. Ramos said a family who was a member of the church anonymously donated money to help pay his tuition.

"I always said if I had an opportunity in the future, one of my goals would be to establish a program to help other young people, like that family helped me," Ramos said.

Several of the students who received scholarships are immigrants to the United States who came to the country speaking little to no English. All overcame difficulties to achieve academic success.
