Amendment to Remove the California College Republicans from the List of Permanently-Chartered Organizations

Whereas the election of Republican candidates for public office and the broader goals of the Republican Party are only achievable with a thriving ecosystem of Republican-aligned organizations; and

Whereas the primary California Republican youth organization, the California College Republicans (CCR), has proven itself incapable of conducting itself in a proper manner and maintaining healthy relationships with the Party and other Republicans; and

Whereas the local chapters of the Republican Party and other Republican-aligned organizations have been grossly underserved by the California College Republicans; and

Whereas the spirit of “permanently chartered organizations” as mentioned in CRP Bylaws Section 3.01(D)(2) assumes a greater level of significance and positive influence, which are two characteristics that CCR clearly lacks as an organization; and

Whereas there are credible alternative organizations that the California Republican Party can affiliate with to spread its influence among the Californian youth on a long-term basis; therefore

Be it RESOLVED that the CRP shall amend Bylaws Section 3.01(D)(2) to strike the phrase “the California College Republicans;” from the Standing Bylaws.
