PROPOSED BY-LAW CHANGES
Affecting Article II, Section 2.01.01

Intent:

The purpose of the proposed change is to rectify the current status of elected Regional Vice Chairs serving on the CAGOP Board of Directors (B.O.D.) which is inherently inequitable versus other elected positions on the B.O.D. in that these elected Regional Vice Chairs do not hold delegate status as a function of that position. Regional Vice Chairs are elected by the delegates from across their respective regions. This is ,de facto, a subset of the delegates who vote to elect state party officers. Therefore, to deny them the same official delegate status is discriminatory and inherently unjust and unfair to the men and women holding these positions.

Amend Article II Section 2.01 as follows: State Central Committee Delegates
Section 2.01.01 Delegates

(A) The following shall be regular delegates of the Committee

(3) The Chairman, the State Vice Chairman, Regional Vice Chairmen and all past Chairmen of the Committee
