**Report of the Volunteer Organizations Committee to the
California Republican Party
January 22, 2019**

On January 16 the Volunteer Organizations Committee received the petition of the California Impact Republicans to become a fully chartered volunteer organization of the California Republican Party Charter.

The Committee conducted its investigation in accordance with Section 3.01 (B) (3) of the California Republican Party By-laws. During the review it was verified that the California Impact Republicans met the requirement of being chartered by at least three county Republican parties in three of the party's eight regions, had a minimum of ten chapters comprised of at least ten registered Republicans each, and a statewide membership of a minimum 200 persons.

The California Impact Republican submitted its Bylaws, governing

documents, charters from county parties and the names and addresses of its officers and members, which were verified through PDI and phone calls by the members of the Volunteer Organizations Committee.

Upon completion of this thorough review, the Volunteer Organizations Committee met by conference call on January 22 and determined that the California Impact Republicans exceeded all the requirements of Section 3.01 (B) (3) and voted unanimously (10 to 0, with 4 absent) to recommend to the delegates that the California Impact Republicans' petition for a Full Charter be granted at the February 2019 Convention.
