About the GGHH Pacific Network:

GGHH is a worldwide network of health institutions working to reduce the health sector's environmental footprint and foster a healthy future for people and the planet.

The Climate and Health Alliance co-ordinates GGHH in the Pacific Region (Australia and New Zealand). GGHH is a project of international Non-Governmental Organisation, Health Care Without Harm.

As of February 2020, there were 82 GGHH members representing the interests of over 1,700 hospitals and health services across Australia and New Zealand.

Globally there are over 1,300 members from 65 countries representing the interests of over 36,000 hospitals and health services.

GGHH Pacific is a collaborative community in which members

learn from one another by sharing information and experiences to help accelerate the transition to low carbon, environmentally sustainable healthcare across the world.

GGHH members in Australia and New Zealand are being internationally recognised for their accomplishments in greening the health sector and improving global public health through action on climate change.

Reduce hospital water consumption and supply potable water



FOOD

Purchase and serve sustainably grown, healthy food



BUILDINGS

Support green and healthy hospital design and construction



CHEMICALS

Substitute harmful chemicals with safer alternatives



ENERGY

Implement energy efficiency and clean, renewable energy generation



TRANSPORTATION

Improve transportation strategies for patients and staff



PHARMACEUTICALS

Prescribe appropriately, safely manage and properly dispose of pharmaceuticals



PURCHASING

Buy safer and more sustainable products and materials

Membership: GGHH membership is free of charge for hospitals, health care facilities, health systems and health professional and academic organisations.

As a joining member, your organisation or health service will select two goals to pledge to work towards. These are chosen from the ten goals that are laid out in the GGHH Agenda and aim to address and promote greater sustainability and environmental health within the sector.

Once an organisation becomes a member, all nominated employees can access the online tools and resources that are available, including:

outline opportunities to reduce environmental impacts within a goal area, including a step by step guide and links to further resource.

- Online data centre to assist with measuring environmental impacts and tracking progress.
- Case studies provided by the international network of GGHH members that highlight successful initiatives across the ten goals.
- Webinars offered on topics including the GGHH goals, current events of interest, and important research and publications
- Newsletters that are sent bi-monthly will provide information such as upcoming events, new tools and resources, and news from the international GGHH network.
- Pacific region member meetings that provide an opportunity to network with others working in sustainable healthcare.
