ORDER

Case Status

Based upon plaintiffs’ verified complaint<sup>1</sup> and their motion for emergency ex parte temporary restraining order and/or preliminary injunction<sup>2</sup> and, after a hearing in which counsel for plaintiffs and defendants participated, the court entered a temporary restraining order.<sup>3</sup> That order contained a schedule for briefing on plaintiffs’ motion for preliminary injunction.

Plaintiffs and defendants have now entered into a stipulation regarding the temporary restraining order and motion for preliminary injunction.<sup>4</sup>

The stipulation of the parties is approved. Plaintiffs' motion for preliminary injunction is moot, and is deemed withdrawn in light of the parties' stipulation.

In accordance with the parties' stipulation, the court's temporary restraining order shall remain in effect and shall be observed by the parties pending a further order of the court. That means defendants will abide by the terms of the restraining order, absent a further order of the court, through the end of the current month of Ramadan, and during any subsequent month of Ramadan in the event this litigation is still pending during any such subsequent month of Ramadan. Accordingly, no further briefing is required at this time.

Defendants' response to plaintiffs' complaint shall be timely served and filed in due course. Concurrent herewith, the court will issue its Rule 16(b) minute order, calling for a scheduling and planning report from the parties.
