The Council on American-Islamic Relations' (CAIR) annual Rosa Parks Civil Liberties Scholarship honors the life and work of civil rights pioneer Rosa Parks. This year's winner of the **\$1,000** scholarship will be announced at CAIR's 19th annual banquet on Saturday, September 28th in Arlington, VA. The winner of the scholarship **must be present** to accept the award. **Applicants must respond to the following essay prompt in 500 words or less:**

**Describe an experience that illustrates
your connection to advancing equality in America.**

In order to qualify, applicants must:

- **Be able to attend CAIR's 19th annual fundraising banquet on Saturday, September 28, 2013** to receive the award in person.
- **Answer the essay question** above in 500 words or less.
- **Be enrolled in or accepted to** a full-time undergraduate, graduate or professional program of an accredited college or university in the United States for the fall 2013 semester.
- **Submit a resume demonstrating** a commitment to civil liberties issues and/or community service.
- **Submit a short bio statement (150 words or less)**
- **Submit one letter of recommendation.**
- **Sign** the attestation and application signature portion of the application.
- Submit a complete application **emailed or postmarked no later than August 1, 2013.**
