Thursday 30th January 2020

After approval of the minutes of the last meeting, we discussed updates to a policy on joint events with other organizations. Specifically it was agreed that we approve having our three pre-Pride social events each year jointly organized and co-branded with the American National Gay Pilots Association. We had informally raised this with their Co-Chairs in November, and we will be contacting them to finalize the arrangements.

We reported that that the annual federal Corporations Canada filing has been completed and confirmation of this was circulated to all Board members. The Annual General Meeting date was set for Wednesday 25th March, and two Directors' terms come up for renewal. The 2019 financial statements will be presented at the meeting.

A detailed events list was prepared and is shown in this newsletter, and it was encouraging to see that several volunteers are already engaged in helping us with some of this year's projects, and several others have come forward to express interest in taking on some of the CAP workload. An annual report for 2019 will be prepared over the next two months.


