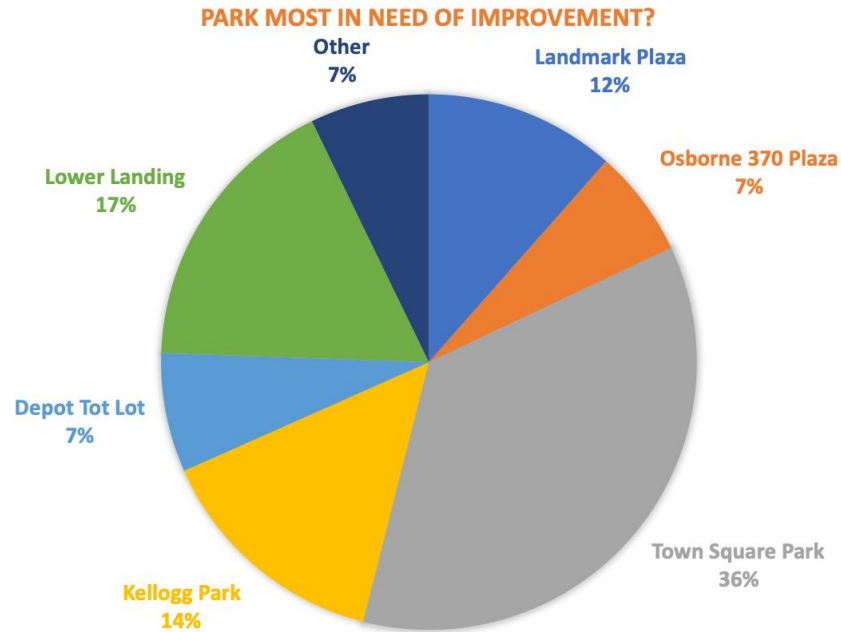


Results from Downtown St. Paul Park Spaces - Community Interest Survey

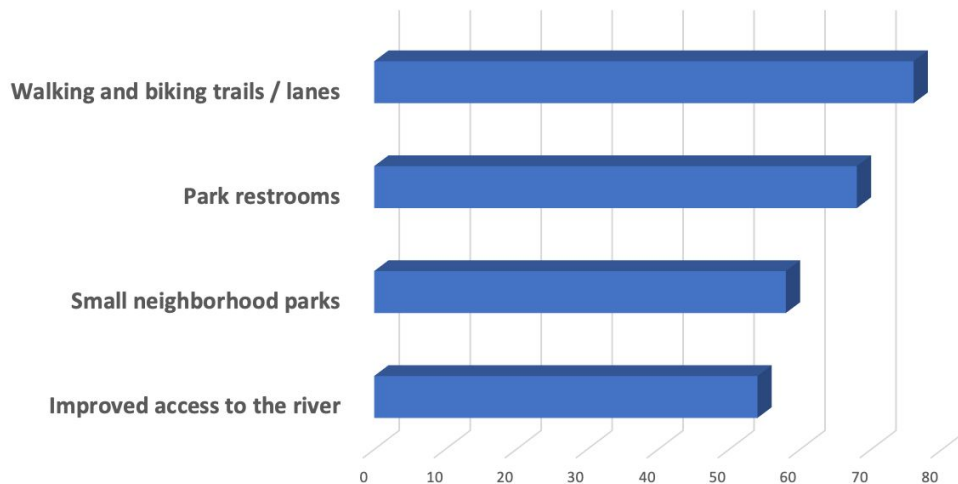


“Town Square Park would be great if it was open again. What a lovely place it would be in Winter.”
