

Sec. 140.09. - Safety requirements.

(4) **On and after June 1, 1991**, all areas of the pedestrian skyway system shall provide a continuous, immediate, accessible and easy-to-perform means of communicating requests to the emergency dispatch center or "911." Communications may be provided by auto-dialed emergency response call boxes, working pay phones or other appropriate calling devices. There shall be a minimum of one (1) means of communication located every three hundred twenty (320) feet measured linearly and a minimum of one (1) means of communication per building. **These means of communication shall be located in prominent locations as determined by the skyway governance advisory committee and accessible during all hours of skyway operation.** In areas where a means of communication is not visible, signage with directions to the nearest location shall be prominently displayed.
