**CARECEN LA ANNOUNCES DATES FOR FREE STUDY SESSIONS FOR THOSE WHO PLAN
TO TAKE THE DRIVING TEST UNDER AB60**

(Thursday, January 16, 2015, Los Angeles) – CARECEN LA announces the dates for study sessions planned to help those who want to request a drivers' license under the new AB60 law, which allows for people without legal status in the United States to apply.

In these sessions, teachers will review questions in translation and administer practice exams. The sessions are free and will take place at CARECEN's offices, 2845 W. 7th St., Los Angeles, CA 90005. CARECEN reminds prospective applicants that there are only three opportunities to take the written portion of the test, and the Spanish translations can be difficult to understand. Those who decide to take the exam should study first to guarantee success.
