Hello,

On behalf of the Olympic Park Neighborhood Council, I urge the 2020 Citizens Redistricting Commission to keep the borders of Olympic Park Neighborhood in the same legislative districts for State and Federal redistricting. Currently, local governance of our board is made difficult by the fact that our 22,000 constituents are split in our representation by three different State Assemblymembers, two State Senators, and two House Representatives. When the redistricting commission redraws district borders this year, the Olympic Park Neighborhood Council Board would greatly appreciate our contiguous placement in a single district, especially given that we are a relatively small council district in Los Angeles County.
