RESOLUTION NO. 2021-36

**A RESOLUTION URGING THE CALIFORNIA CITIZENS REDISTRICTING COMMISSION TO
KEEP LAKE COUNTY, NAPA COUNTY AND SONOMA COUNTY WITHIN THE SAME
UNITED STATES CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT**

WHEREAS, as a result of the passage of Proposition 20 by California voters in 2010, the California Citizens Redistricting Commission is responsible to establish new Congressional District boundaries based on information gathered through the decennial Census; and

WHEREAS, Lake County currently shares a United States Congressional District with Napa and Sonoma Counties; and

WHEREAS, Lake County shares many interests with Napa and Sonoma Counties, including the winegrape, geothermal and tourism industries, and regional watersheds and water rights; and

WHEREAS, these points of common interest provide strong ties and long-term relationships among our three counties, making common representation and advocacy in a shared Congressional District truly critical; and

WHEREAS, we appreciate the difficult job the Redistricting Commission has in trying to balance competing interests in drawing District lines, and keeping Lake, Napa and Sonoma Counties together is not geographically sensible, but conforms with the Redistricting Commission's non-partisan rules to create Districts of relatively equal population, providing fair representation for all Californians; and

WHEREAS, we, the members of the Lake County Board of Supervisors, therefore find the residents of our three counties will be best served by remaining in the same Congressional District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

The Lake County Board of Supervisors of the County of Lake, State of California, strongly urges the California Citizens Redistricting Commission to keep Lake, Napa and Sonoma Counties within the same United States Congressional District, to provide the most logical, efficient and effective representation possible.
