Friends, I am concerned about the nesting issue. During the last redistricting nesting was a low level requirement, however, after the last redistricting was completed it was obvious to me that nesting was not followed. This time I suggest starting with the Assembly districts, then create Senate districts by having it completely be comprised of two Assembly districts, then join 10 Senate districts to create one Board of Equalization district. When the legislature failed to create districts years ago, the judges were able to nest two Assembly districts into one Senate district. I know elected officials do not like nesting, but I think it is possible and it is the correct thing to do. Please follow nesting rules this time around.
