Message Body:

League of Women Voters Riverside writes to ask that the Citizens Redistricting Commission make as few changes as possible to the voting districts encompassing and surrounding the City of Riverside. These districts include the 60th and 61st Assembly Districts, the 31st Senate District and 41st Congressional District.

LWV Riverside and our community partners were very active in the commission's first round of redistricting. We defined our communities of interest and the commission responded. Our combined efforts produced ideal districts – the 60th and 61st Assembly Districts are nestled in the 31st Senate District and all three districts are overlaid by the 41st Congressional District.

Since 2012, voting patterns have been consistent. Moderate-leaning representatives were initially elected and overwhelmingly re-elected. We assume this reflects the common interests of voters in our diverse and well-drawn districts.

Our demographic shifts have been minor. We are hopeful you will make as few changes as possible to the 60th and 61st AD, the 31st SD, and the 41st CD.
