I live in Roseville, CA, having moved here a little more than 6 years ago. Since then, Roseville has continued to grow significantly with all of the challenges that brings – increasing traffic, greater impacts on both water and power supply, and rapidly changing demographics.

Along with Roseville, Tahoe City, and other cities and town in Placer County, other communities in the region face similar issues. This includes cities and towns ranging from Folsom in Sacramento County, Nevada City and Grass Valley in Nevada County, and Placerville, South Lake Tahoe, and Pollack Pines in El Dorado County. All of these communities are facing similar issues about growth, transportation (both the 80 and 50 corridors run through this region – major commuter routes in the Sacramento area), water supply and management, and, increasingly, wildfire impacts.

I believe that a district composed of Nevada, Placer, and El Dorado Counties, along with the city of Folsom, has significant interests in common, and would be a compact district representing an exurban area of the greater Sacramento area. Our current congressional boundaries roll us in with Amador, Calaveras, and Fresno Counties, all of which are great places, but with very different interests from the potential district I describe.
