To Whom It May Concern:


On August 4, 2021 at the regularly scheduled Brown Act compliant meeting of the Lake Balboa Neighborhood Council, the board members voted to support (10,0,2,4,0) the following:

1. Our community is best served by a redistricting that maximized the number of districts that are either wholly within the Valley or in which the Valley is the most influential voter bloc;
2. To ensure full and adequate representation for the San Fernando Valley, we support Valley-only Council districts with the exception of one Council district
3. If it is necessary to merge one Valley seat with areas outside of the Valley, the preference is to have a minimum of 50% of that district within the San Fernando Valley;
4. Our goals for redistricting are non-partisan and are only to be shaped by the interest of maximizing representation and advancing goals of Valley businesses and residents;
5. All legally recognized communities should be kept together as part of compact and contiguous districts which shall recognize geographic features and natural boundaries.

Lake Balboa Neighborhood Council represents approximately 50,000 stakeholders who wish to have San Fernando Valley representation who understand our regional individuality and unique municipalities.
