Please review the below, and thank you for your attention:

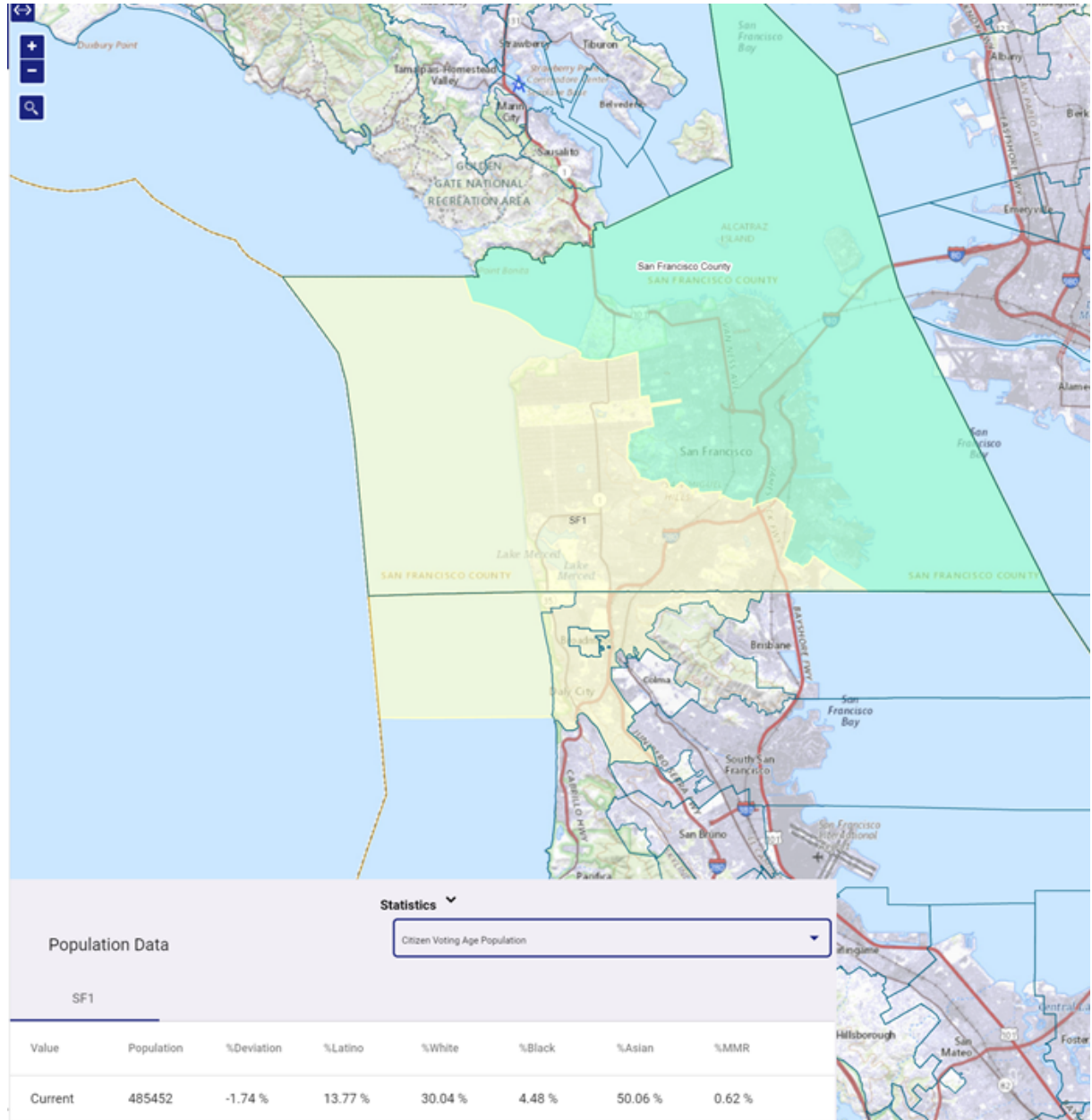
San Francisco and Daly City almost perfectly form a Senate District.
