I live in the Dogpatch neighborhood of San Francisco. This new neighborhood used to be a part of the shipping hub that lined the eastern side of San Francisco and therefore faces a number of old industrial sites and buildings.

The demographics data for Dogpatch is often combined with the nearby Potrero Hill community. This community is bordered by 17th and 16th streets to the north, the San Francisco Bay to the east, Highway 101 to the west, and 29th street to the south. According to the American Community Survey, the Potrero Hill community has significant Spanish and Asian Language speaking communities (10% and 9% respectively). The unique and historical environmental issues that face this community should be considered in the redistricting process and not be broken up.
