I also wanted to provide my feedback:

- ADImperialCoachella\_1003 [Page 22]: My preferred Assembly District. Keeps the Salton Sea and Eastern Coachella whole, while providing a meaningful opportunity for Latinos to elect.

- ImperialESanDiego\_1004 [Page 20]: Also an Assembly District, but not my preferred option. But thanks again for requesting both options!

- SDandRiversideTribalLandsWImperial\_1004 [Page 18];

CoachellaImperial\_1004 [Page 21]: Imperial has little to do with eastern San Diego.

For future visualizations, I would like to ask for the following options:

- Congress: Start with ADImperialCoachella\_1003 [Page 22]. Add the rest of the Coachella Valley, then along I-10 until you have around 750,000 people.

- Senate: Combine ImperialESanDiego\_1004 [Page 20] with southwestern San Diego [pages 8-13], plus whatever else is needed in San Diego for approximately 1 million people.

You could also combine ADImperialCoachella\_1003 and BarrioLoganLoganHeights\_1004, but don't need another visualization and your team already has plenty of work to do.
