Who is Marshall Tuck?

Marshall Tuck is running for State Superintendent of Public Instruction, the elected official charged with running the Department of Education.

Tuck has been endorsed by almost every major newspaper in the state and is pulling ahead of incumbent Tom Torlakson, according to the [most recent Field poll](#).

From 2002 to 2007, Tuck served as President of [Green Dot Public Schools](#), a leading charter school operator based in Los Angeles, which he helped expand from one school to 10 charter high schools by 2006. Green Dot schools consistently outperform comparable schools' graduation rates and overall academic achievement, and five of its high schools were [recently recognized](#) as "America's Best" by the *Daily Beast*.

Marshall's plan

Marshall has a [multi-pronged plan](#) to get the state's public education system back on track. His plan includes provisions for improving local decision-making and parent engagement in schools, calling for more great principals and effective teachers, developing a robust college- and career-ready curriculum and expanding 21st century technology in the classrooms.
