

How to Access and Use the Department of Mines and Petroleum – Petroleum and Geothermal Register

- Go to <http://dmp.wa.gov.au/>
- Hover your cursor over the big blue button on the left hand side of the page titled ONLINE SYSTEMS
- move the cursor over into the drop down selection and click on Petroleum And Geothermal Register (PGR)
- When the next page opens, click on the link displayed in red text "access to Petroleum and Geothermal Register (PGR)
- When the next page opens, click on the black 'register' button in the 'New User Registration' box
- Complete the online form and follow the directions. A user name and password will be sent to your email account. - NOTE: this may take up to a day.

Once you have registered, you can search the register either by company name, Exploration Permit Number eg. EP 413. Or alternatively you can search by region eg Perth Basin, Canning Basin, Carnarvon Basin.

You can use the interactive map of tenements provided (this will open on the same page as the tenement details and includes surrounding tenements) - just hover the cursor over the map and tenements will highlight in red. click on the highlighted tenement and it will display the tenement details.

- Click on the Holders, Works and Blocks tab

This will allow you to see what the timeline of works is, who the operator is, and what other companies are involved.

You will be able to see what year they will intend to do seismic surveys, what year they intend to drill a well etc.
