

# NVP REPORT -AB, NWT & NUNAVUT

APRIL 2019

In mid-December I took over as National Vice President for our Region, AB, NWT & Nunavut. I spend the first few weeks playing catch up reviewing 100's of emails to go over. Over the last 3 months I've attended numerous monthly and weekly conference calls for ESDC Western Region for IRB, RLMCC's for IRCC Western Region and RLMCC's and monthly touch base calls for Service Canada as well. In addition I've participated in ESDC Western Region calls on Pay Transformation, IRB OSH conference call and our Regional Women's Committee.

Recently, I have also suggested and am in the process of initiating a conference call for all 4 CPC's, Edmonton, Mississauga, Sydney and OSC's Local Executive, to consult with each other regarding issued in their perspective offices. Many times I have heard that the excuse Management gives is because it is done at other CPC offices.

I'm hoping that by reaching out to each other that they can make Management in their perspective offices accountable.
