

**NVP REPORT**  
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**SEPT. 2019 – JUNE 2020**

From September until February the majority of my time was spent on Mobilization within our Region. Almost every Wednesday and every Friday we would hold Rallies throughout the Region in support of our Bargaining Team. I also spent time ensuring that all Local Executives in my Regional attended PSAC's Strike Training.

I continued to attend all Regional Touch Base meetings with all 3 Departments in our Region, OSH Committee meetings with IRB, RLMCC's with IRCC and Service Canada and Phoenix Pay Transformation Meetings.
