### **CEIU National Executive meetings**

I participate to the regular meetings that are done virtually.

### **CEIU Mental Health national committee**

We have met via Zoom on October 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2020. I invite you consult our report.

### **Service Canada - meetings**

Throughout the months, I have attended bilateral business line meetings: Customer Services Direction (CSD), Strategic Services Direction (SSD), Integrity Services Direction (ISD), Programs Direction (PD), Payment Delivery Services Direction (PDSD). These meetings take place every 2 or 3 weeks. JLP: follow up on the workshop during our monthly call. Since the beginning of the pandemic, the planification of the workshops has been put on hole. But JLP have created a series of 3 Empowering conversation, that are in great demands.

Contacting all union locals

We have a 1-hour conference calls, with the union locales presidents. Our calls take place every 2 weeks and are greatly appreciated. Our last call was on June 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2020. Afterwards we have been communicating by e-mail.

### **ROSH Meeting**

I co-presided the meeting that took place on June 6<sup>th</sup>, 2020, the next meeting is schedules for October 20<sup>th</sup>, 2020. On April 9<sup>th</sup> and September 24<sup>th</sup>, 2020, it was a conference call with the members of the ROSH committee and all the co-presidents and representative of local OHS committee.

### **IRCC / RUMCC**

We did not have any meetings with the managers responsible of the Eastern Nation network, but we have conference calls every 2 weeks with IRCC in reference about the pandemic and the working conditions of the employees.

**PHSC meetings:** Since March 18<sup>th</sup>, 2020 we have conference calls every 2 to 3 weeks. The main subject is the pandemic and the working conditions.

There were also ad-hoc meetings on a specific subject. The last meeting took place October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020. Starting December 8<sup>th</sup>, 2020, we will be back to the regular schedule for our meetings.

**Working group on C-65 (Sub-committee of PHSC),** At the last meeting of the PHSC that took place on October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020 it was confirmed that the working group will start back the meetings. Because it was specified that the Law comes into effect on January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021.

### **PHSC Environmental Sensitiveness Working Group (sub-committee of PHSC)**

The meetings by teleconference took place on December 5<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup>, 2019 and also on January 28<sup>th</sup>, 2020. The purpose of this working group is to present recommendations to PHSC, that will be part of an action plan that also includes a communications plan for all employees and members of management. That was done on February 25<sup>th</sup>, 2020. We will help the PHSC with their communications plan. Because of the actual pandemic, the subject as not been discussed during the Covid meetings. The subject will be on the agenda for the next meeting.

### **Meeting of the ESDC Workplace Mental Health Advisory Committee**

No new dates were scheduled, but they contact me regularly before sending out communications.

### **AED (Automatic External Defibrillator) Campaign**

Following the monthly calls and the petition that was sent to national assembly, a letter was sent by CEIU to Graham Flack. The subject will be on the agenda of the next PSHC meeting
