2018 Activity Report

This activity report represents an overview of union activities and responsibilities of elected officers of the NCR for the year 2018.

CEIU

The NVP:

- Holds the office of National Vice President for the NCR under the Canada Employment Immigration Union (CEIU);
- Is responsible for 7 local sections with 28 elected officers under each respective local section within the Employment and Social Development Canada (ESDC)/Service Canada, Immigration Refugee and Citizenship Canada (IRCC), and the Immigration Refugee Board (IRB);
- Is supported by three (3) alternates to the VPN for the NCR.

PSAC

The NVP represents the component’s second largest region comprised of 4100 members out of total membership of 22,000.

Regional responsibilities

The NVP:

- Chairs of the NCR executive council (CEO);
- Co-chairs of the NCR Presidents Council;
- Is an ex officio member on all local sections under the CEIU-NCR;
- Is a member on the NCR youth Committee;
- Is a member on the NCR HRRR Committee;
- Is an ex officio member of the NCR youth Committee;
- Is an ex officio member of the NCR Women’s Issues Committee;
- Is a co-chair of the 18 branch joint LUMCC’ s at ESDC/Service Canada coupled with IRCCs and IRBs;
- Co-chairs NCR IRB LUMCC;

- Co-chairs NCR IRCC LUMCC;
- Is a member of the ESDC/Service Canada National HRLUMCC;
- Is a member of the ESDC/Service Canada SCLUMCC;
- Has overseen and delivered an extensive training program for members and union executives throughout the year;
- Held monthly activities on a multitude of varied topics;
- Is responsible for review of all job descriptions touched by the implementation of structural model for the region under ESDC/Service Canada;
- Reviewed and approved all proposed exclusion requests;
- Reviewed and approved all job description and business cases related essential service position requests;
- Is a recognized PSAC facilitator and trainer;
- Sits as a PSAC advocate with regional executive responsibilities;
- Is responsible for organizing and mobilization activities on behalf of the PSAC for the component for the NCR.

National Responsibilities

The NVP:

- Is a sitting member of the governing body on the CEIU National Executive;
- Is co-chair of the National Finance Committee;
- Is a member of the Service Delivery Committee;
- Is a member of the National Call Centre Committee;
- Is a member on the National IRCC Committee;
- Is an ex officio member on the National HRRR Committee;
- Is a member on the National Immigration Refugee Board (IRB) Committee;
- Is a member on the CEIU Negotiation Team;
- Is a special advisor to the component's National President and National Executive Vice President (NEVP);
- Is chair of the National Convention Credentials Committee;
- Is a point of contact for Employment Assistance program (EAP) conflict resolution and assistance;
- Is a trained Canadian Labour Congress (CLC) conflict resolution mitigator;
- Is a trained PSAC facilitator;

Please note that all complaints are filed locally but mitigated and resolved regionally by the office he holds.

The NVP works with every ADMs and S/ADM's and their respective DG's across the 3 departments to mitigate and address issues of mutual concern daily, hourly and 24 / 7.

Other Issues

PSAC is in contract negotiations and potential strike action is possible

The NVP will be involved in the strike vote and contract offer processes to come and any related upcoming activities.

In a nutshell, he is at the beck and call of all activities listed and their respective areas of responsibilities.

Most significantly, the 4100 members in his region, many of which have issues due to circumstances, need guidance and representation and they turn up daily each with their own story and needs that go with it.
