On 04/18/13 at about 10:00am a [REDACTED] DOB: [REDACTED] 59 walked into the CFPD to drop off a Standardized Complaint Form (SCF) that she had completed. [REDACTED] stated that she has been in and out of Butler Hospital and was making a complaint against a female officer from her arrest on 02/22/12. The arrest was later learned to be 12-174-AR. Denny claims that the female officer used excessive force when she was arrested in her apartment at [REDACTED] Sylvian Street 2nd floor. The narrative from her SCF states she dropped off a journal detailing the incident. No journal was located when I received this complaint to investigate.

From arrest report 12-174-AR from 02/22/12, Officer [REDACTED] Officer [REDACTED] and Officer [REDACTED] responded to [REDACTED] Sylvian Street 2nd floor to deal with [REDACTED]. CFPD received a 911 call from a male, later ID as [REDACTED] who stated he was hiding in a bedroom closet to get away from his intoxicated girlfriend who was yelling and screaming at him. Officers arrived on scene and saw [REDACTED] sitting on the couch and she was very angry and upset that [REDACTED] would not open the bedroom door. [REDACTED] did appear highly intoxicated. [REDACTED] opened the door and spoke with officers. [REDACTED] was yelling and swearing at [REDACTED] and stated she wanted him out of the house. [REDACTED] was asked if [REDACTED] struck her or hurt her in any way and she stated no. [REDACTED] agreed to stay in his bedroom and [REDACTED] initially agreed to calm down. As officers were leaving and in the hallway, [REDACTED] came out her apartment and was yelling and swearing at the officers to not come back and she came be as loud and vulgar as she wanted. [REDACTED] stated that if [REDACTED] locked that bedroom door she would kick it in. Officers asked her several times to calm down and go back into her apartment. [REDACTED] refused and continued to scream. [REDACTED] was placed under arrest for disorderly conduct. [REDACTED] was transported to the station and processed and released with a Municipal Court summons. While in the cell area, [REDACTED] was making suicidal threats so she was transported by Central Falls Rescue to Pawtucket Memorial Hospital for evaluation.

I then attempted to contact [redacted] but her numerous phone numbers are either out of service or assigned to someone new. [redacted] did not provide any pictures or medical records to substantiate her claims. This investigation and therefore closed at this time and found to be unsubstantiated.
