On 10/10/2017, I received this complaint.

On 10/12/2017, at approximately 1415 HRS, I called and left a message for the reporting party. [REDACTED] returned my called at 1419 HRS and left me a message. At approximately 1422 HRS, I called and left a message for the reporting party again. At approximately 1435 HRS, I spoke with [REDACTED]. Upon speaking with her, it was discovered she had no standing with what the officer did the morning in question (10/02/2017). [REDACTED] had responded to [REDACTED] Sylvian Street in an attempt to locate family members of a victim involved in a motor vehicle accident with serious injuries. [REDACTED] did not have a complaint with her personal interactions with [REDACTED] that morning. She didn't think it was right for [REDACTED] to enter her first floor tenant's apartment after he had been told the victim of the accident to not have family at that address. She just wanted the officer to be told not to enter an apartment uninvited next time. I told her I would speak with [REDACTED] but also, I needed to here from the first floor tenant [REDACTED] for a formal complaint to take place. I did ask [REDACTED] about this incident and he told me he was just trying to find family members of the accident victim. He did not go into the apartment any further than to ask about any potential family members of the accident victim.

As of this date, 12/18/2017, I have not heard from the first floor tenant or anyone else from the entire house.

The reporting party in this complaint has no standing in the complaint itself. The possible complainant has never come forward with a complaint.

There is no evidence to support [REDACTED] violated any rules & regulations or policies & procedures of the Central Falls PD.
