On 1/28/2020 Victoria Bautista filed a Citizen Complaint form against [REDACTED] regarding a contact on 7/27/19. Bautista complaint is vague but she left a telephone message also stating [REDACTED] lied and put statements on her. I attempted to contact Bautista back by phone with negative results.

Below is the narrative from the initial contact on 7/27/19:

On Saturday July 28th, 2019 at approximately 5:46 p.m., officers responded to Segue Middle School on Cowden Street for the report of a possible domestic disturbance. Dispatch advised officer's that the caller, whom identified himself as the schools maintenance worker, observed a male hit a female outside in the parking lot and the female was wearing a gray shirt.

Upon arrival, I, [REDACTED] observed a female matching the description and a male sitting on the side steps of the school. Both party's attempted to leave but I asked them to take a seat. Neither party appeared upset, injured or otherwise in distress. The female stated, "I didn't know we were trespassing". I advised the female officers we're not there for that issue and explained to her the actual reason. I asked the male and female if they had gotten into any altercation, to which both stated no. The male stated they were just talking. Both were asked what sort of relationship they have and both replied that they were "just friends". The male went on to state that they were talking about his "baby mama's problems" he's having. At this time, I asked both party's to identify themselves. The male stated he was Jordy Tavera, [REDACTED] 1999 [REDACTED] years old). The female stated she was Alexandria Smith [REDACTED] 1999. Both stated they did not have no positive form of identification on their person and that both lived in Providence, RI and have never been arrested. They stated they had come to Central Falls to watch a soccer game. There was in fact a soccer tournament just up on Cowden Street at that time. Dispatch advised me there was no record of both names. It should be noted when speaking with Tavera I believe to know him from personal interactions during high school. I advised [REDACTED] I may have played sports with Tavera together in high school and explained to him I believe him to be lying in regards to his identity. I believed his name may be Jonathan, however, I was not completely sure. Additionally, I was able to remember that he was a year above me during high school and believed the date of birth he gave officers could be false as well. [REDACTED] attempted to make contact with the caller, however, he received no answer and was unable to gather any additional information. [REDACTED] attempted to locate any police contacts with either party via police laptop. Negative results for any combination of both names and date of births resulted. Officers were unable to observe any visible marks or injuries on either Tavera or Smith. Both party's became very uncooperative and kept stating they wanted to leave and they there had been no issue. The witness could still not be located. Due to the fact that there was no complaint and no evidence of any assault or establishment of a "domestic relationship", the two subjects were sent from the scene. At that time, officers could not confirm nor deny their identities.

After leaving the scene I attempted to locate the male through Social Media as I believed we may have mutual friends. I was able to locate a Face Book profile of Tavera which had a picture of him and the name for the page was "Benny Ortiz". I conducted a Cross Agency check of the name Jonathan Ortiz and was able to locate a male by the name having had interactions with Pawtucket Police. The search contained a photograph of the male to which I was able to positively identify him as the male we dealt with, Jonathan Ortiz [REDACTED] 1995. A status check with dispatch also confirmed Ortiz has warrants for his arrest as well as an active No Contact Order protecting a female, Victoria Bautista [REDACTED] 1999 which was the result of previous criminal cases. In fact, Pawtucket Police had just taken a complaint regarding a violation of the NCO earlier today involving the same two parties and have charges of Violation of NCO-3rd/Subsequent Offense against Ortiz.

Officers immediately began canvassing the area in an attempt to locate Ortiz. In doing so we were only able to locate the female we had dealt with who initially identified herself as Alexandria Smith at the corner of

Dexter Street and Cowden Street. Pawtucket Police responded and positively identified the female as the protected party, Victoria Bautista, with whom they dealt with earlier today. Bautista continued to be very uncooperative and did not want to comment further on the matter. While speaking with Bautista she stated it was up to us to "figure it out" and ran off and took a RIPTA bus that was driving by.

Pawtucket Police was notified of the additional charges now on Ortiz and were also canvassing the area in an attempt to locate. At this time, Bautista was not taken into custody for obstruction due to her status as a possible victim. This report will be forwarded in an attempt to obtain an arrest warrant.

[REDACTED] and RISP later responded to two last known addresses in Pawtucket in an attempt to locate Ortiz with negative results. There is a possible address of 58 Beacon Street in Providence.

On 1/29/2020 I contacted Bautista and asked her to further explain her complaint. Bautista stated Ofc. Rivera doesn't like her baby daddy Jonathan Ortiz and got him arrested for assaulting her by lying in the report that Jonathan hit me. Bautista admitted that when police arrived she lied about her name to protect Ortiz and would always lie to police. She stated [REDACTED] only found out Jonathan real name by looking on Facebook and he shouldn't be able to do that.

I advised Bautista that the Central Falls police did not charge Ortiz with assault and nowhere in the narrative did [REDACTED] claim she made a statement. Bautista stated well some department charged him with assaulting me but I hit him first and you can't find the janitor so it's all bullshit. I advised Bautista once more we did not charge Ortiz with assault and [REDACTED] didn't state anything about an assault so he did not lie. I believe if Ortiz was charged with an assault it would be Pawtucket police. She finally agreed and admitted she was uncooperative with police and it wasn't [REDACTED] who got Ortiz charged with assault.

I asked her why she reported this to the department now six months later she stated that she just went to court to get the protection order dropped and was denied by DCFY and wants police to drop the order. I advised Bautista we cannot help her with the order and [REDACTED] was well within his right to use whatever means necessary to identify Ortiz and her.

Findings:

Based on the narrative from the incidents 19-934-OF @ 19-935-OF [REDACTED] did not provide false information leading to an arrest for assault and [REDACTED] didn't claim to have taken any statement from Bautista. As for how positive identification was made [REDACTED] used all legal means necessary to properly do his job and didn't violate any policy or Rule and Regulation.
