On 08/18/17 I received this complaint for investigation at that time I reviewed the Citizen Form and attached letter. I then printed and reviewed department incident number related to this case 17-1129-OF.

On 08/22/17 I spoke with Mr. Erazo to determine what is exact complaint is with the incident and see if he would provide further details. He stated he was heated at the time and now has no complaint with the officers and does not wish to proceed. Mr. Erazo did say the dog scratched his vehicle. I advised him a citizen complaint will not address that issue. I advised him he should contact his insurance and file a complaint with the city clerk if he did in fact suffer any damage to his vehicle. Mr. Erazo stated it was minor and forget everything. I provided Mr. Erazo one last opportunity to explain his citizen complaint or ask any questions. Mr. Erazo stated he had nothing else to say other than I don't deal drugs.

I then spoke with [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] about what took place during a court executed search warrant of [REDACTED] Perry Street and there arrival at the address. Both explained upon arrival a male target took off running from aside of Mr. Erazo vehicle as officers chased after the male Mr. Erazo left the scene by driving over a curb to get around both marked and unmarked vehicles that blocked him. Based on his actions and information he was involved they searched for him and located his vehicle and requested K-9 sniff the exterior. This resulted in positive indications for narcotics and a full search.

Based on the provided incident report and conversations with the officers involved along with the letter from Mr. Erazo and his statement that he does not wish to go forward with any complaint. The complaint is unfounded.
