It is my pleasure to inform you that the City of Central Falls will receive a grant in the amount of \$332,900 from the Rhode Island Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program.

Priority, this year, has been given to activities designed to improve or increase the supply of housing available to low and moderate income families. Among the excellent programs funded statewide this year are development of affordable housing opportunities; job training/development programs assisting low-moderate income persons and various public facility, social and community services agencies.

Approximately \$4.3 million is being awarded to 30 Rhode Island communities. The number and quality of applications received is indicative of the commitment Rhode Island cities and towns have to provide decent housing, expand economic opportunity and improve the quality of life in local neighborhoods.


Specifically, the City of Central Falls is being awarded a grant of \$332,900 for the following activities.
