Executive Order Nuisance Properties Task Force

I, James A. Diossa, Mayor of the City of Central Falls, hereby establish the City of Central Falls Nuisance Properties Task Force.

The mission of the Nuisance Properties Task Force is to address, in a holistic and systematic way, properties identified as nuisances that negatively impact our neighborhoods, the quality of housing available, and the health and life of city residents, businesses and visitors.

The Nuisance Properties Task Force includes representatives from Mayor's Office, Office of the City Solicitor, City Council, Department of Code Enforcement, Fire Department, Police Department, Planning Department and Tax Assessor of the Department of Finance.

The Nuisance Properties Task Force is directed to:

- Complete a comprehensive review, identify improvements and propose revisions of city ordinances
- Create a system to document, track and report on nuisance properties
- Research and document best practices to address nuisance properties
- Identify and implement strategies to address nuisance properties
