



2019 Frederic McGrand Travel Grant **Sponsored by Humane Canada**

Total amount varies by year

This grant provides travel assistance to Humane Canada member societies located in Atlantic Canada in order to attend the 2019 National Animal Welfare Conference in Montreal, April 14-15, 2019. If awarded a Frederic McGrand Travel Grant, you will receive:

- Complementary conference registration, including:
 - 1 ticket to the conference opening social event on April 13
 - 1 ticket to the Animal Welfare Leadership & Innovation Awards on April 14
 - breakfast and lunch on April 14 and 15
 - access to all conference sessions on April 14 and 15
- Complementary 3-night stay at the conference hotel (Hotel Bonaventure Montreal).

Chosen recipients will need to cover their own transportation costs to and from Montreal. Recipients will **not need** to cover the upfront costs of their conference registration and hotel fees. If participants wish to remain in Montreal for a longer period, they will do so at their own expense.

How to apply: Tell us in 500 words or less why you want to attend the 2019 National Animal Welfare Conference in Montreal and how you believe your conference experience will contribute to improving animal welfare. Your application should be submitted to conference@humanecanada.ca, and your subject line should be **Frederic McGrand Travel Grant**.

Deadline to submit applications:	Thursday, January 31
Notifications sent:	Friday, March 8

Restrictions: Only open to employees of Humane Canada member societies in Atlantic Canada. The grant does not include registration to the Deep Dive Training Day on April 16, 2019.

Notes:

- All grant applicants are eligible for the early bird registration rate, even if you are not selected for this grant.
- You may apply for more than one travel grant, however an applicant can only receive one of our travel grants.
