Yukon's Hospital Workers & the Yukon Hospital Corporation resumed talks today in Whitehorse. The renewed negotiations followed the breakdown of discussions and a strong strike vote by the membership.

"The tentative deal achieved today came about through cooperation and mutual respect", says YEU President Steve Geick. "Our members provided their bargaining team with an unwavering mandate and the team worked hard to make sure a fair deal was reached."
