

## GOOD GOVERNMENT AND ETHICS

At a time when many states are putting up new barriers to keep voters from exercising their rights, **I am committed to ensuring that the District leads the nation on fair elections, expanding voter access, and strict campaign finance reforms.** I believe more work is needed to rebuild trust in our local government, and as chair of the committee with oversight of our elections and ethics agencies, I have a track record of success:

- Introduced and passed the **Fair Elections Act**, which creates a public-financing option for candidates running for elected office in DC.
- Authored and passed the **Automatic Voter Registration Act**, which increases voter participation by automatically registering residents to vote when they go to the DMV to get an ID or a driver's license.
- My **Ballot Modernization Amendment Act** allows campaigns to use a mobile petition application, allowing for more accurate signature collection.

As a candidate, I am running this campaign the same way I did four years ago, when **I was the first candidate elected in DC who refused to accept corporate or PAC contributions.**

- I only accept contributions from **individual donors**, and I'm proud that nearly 80% of my donations have come from people who live right here in **Ward 6**.
- My office **does not have a Constituent Services Fund**, which I believe can be too easily used for inappropriate purposes and creates conflicts when donations are received from those seeking to influence votes.
- I believe residents deserve a **fulltime Councilmember** and that outside employment should not be allowed.
- Businesses and individuals who receive District government contracts should not be allowed to donate to the officials who review and approve them. That's why I introduced a **ban on contractor contributions** and am working to pass it this year.
