

Happy New Year!

Welcome to the first edition of the 2020 election year newsletter. This version contains important information about the March primaries, along with how to become a Republican delegate to the County, District, and State conventions. Read further to find out more about volunteering for the election season, and about our 2020 party headquarters.

Primary Elections

Chatham County primary elections will be March 3, 2020.

- The deadline to **register to vote** in the primary election is **February 7, 2020**. You can check your voter registration status [here](#). If you are not registered or need to change your registration, you can do so at the Chatham County Board of Elections, or print out and submit the application found [here](#).
- **Absentee** voting ballots will be available on **January 13, 2020** and must be requested from the Chatham Board of Elections no later than **February 25, 2020**.
- **Early voting** (absentee one-stop voting) begins on **February 13**, and ends on **February 29**.
- **On election day you must vote in your precinct**. You can find your voting location [here](#) or [here](#).

Candidates and Voting

- March is a Primary election, which means the political parties are voting for who they want to see on the General election ballot in November. If you are a Registered Republican or Registered Unaffiliated, you can vote in the Republican primary election.

Spring is Convention Time

The Chatham County Republican **Convention** will be the morning of **March 14**, 2020 in Pittsboro. The County Convention is the hub of Republican representation - it all starts there. This year you will be able to hear from the local Conservative candidates running for office, so plan to attend. We will elect delegates to the District and State Convention, also. More details to follow.

To be a delegate to the Republican **District Conventions** in April or to be a delegate to the **North Carolina Republican Convention (May 14 - 17 in Greenville)**, you **MUST** be elected as a delegate at the County Convention to the District or State conventions..

To be a delegate to the **Republican National Convention** in Charlotte this year, you must be elected at the District Convention.

If you would like to attend as a voting delegate to the Chatham County Convention, you must be registered as a Republican in Chatham County no later than January 31, 2020. You can check on your voters registration at this Board of Elections website: <https://vt.ncsbe.gov/RegLkup/>.
