

The Attack on Individuals, Liberties, Freedoms and Our Country by American Marxists

As a nation, we should oppose such efforts to divide us and reaffirm our common faith in the fundamental equal right of every individual to life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness.¹

Among the virtues to be cultivated in the American republic, the founders knew that a free people must have knowledge of the principles and practices of liberty, and an appreciation of their origins and challenges.

While this country has its imperfections, just like any other country, in the annals of history, the United States has achieved the greatest degree of personal freedom, security, and prosperity for the greatest proportion of its own people and for others around the world. These results are the good fruit of the ideas founded, in generation, expressed as true for all people at all times and places.

An authentic civics education will help rebuild our common bonds, our mutual friendship, and our civic devotion. But we cannot *love* what we do not *know*.

This is why civics education, education relating to the citizen, must begin with knowledge, which is, as George Washington reminds us, “the surest basis of public happiness.”²

“Back in the 1840’s or so Marx was never more powerful with his communist manifesto. It had an enormous influence, particular among intellectuals all over the world including the United States. "Equity is a term that has no meaning," explains [Shelby Steele](#), senior fellow at Stanford University's Hoover Institution, "but it's one that gives blacks power and leverage in American life. We can throw it

around at any time, and wherever it lands, it carries this stigma that somebody's a bigot," an [equity-based system](#) (communism), wherein one's social status is determined by one's position on the Left's victimology hierarchy.

“America is under attack by a rising communist revolutionary movement. They are attacking our republican system of government, which included defaming our nation by attacking its founding. The Left is the enemy of history and memory and hates our nation’s founding principles.

For over 225 years, democratic persuasion – a process made possible by the First Amendment, and by government through consent of the governed – is what has made the American social contract work. Americans talked about their differences, listened to one another and debated and compromised. It was all made possible by mutual respect for the rights of others to dissent and disagree. This is the process to which radical Marxists have laid siege.

Identity politics is an anti – American ideology and a sanitized name for cultural Marxism. Marx viewed market societies as divided into capitalists and workers, to which he ascribed, oral attributes: oppressors and oppressed. Society was the site of continued warfare between classes. Cultural Marxists have extended this picture of class warfare to races, genders and sexual orientations, attributing all to inequality and injustice to the institutions and actions of oppressor groups: whites, males, heterosexuals and religious “reactionaries” – in particular Christians – whose views allegedly serve the interests of the oppressors.

This is the prescription for true oppression, as the government steps in to create “social justice” by depriving those who have earned it, the fruits of their labor, and distributing them to those who have not. In identity politics only collective rights matter – not individual rights.”⁴

Censorship, rewriting history and attacks on Christian doctrines fundamental to the American Republic are practices of totalitarian regimes.

Hannah-Jones is the creator of The 1619 Project for the New York Times Magazine, which reframed the history of slavery in the United States and its role in democracy. It has attracted criticism from conservatives who've since pushed to prohibit the use of federal funds to teach The 1619 Project in K-12 public schools. 1619 along with Critical Race Theory is the Marxist revolutionary movement pushed by Democrats.

“So wrong in so many ways” is how Gordon Wood, the Pulitzer Prize-winning historian of the American Revolution, characterized the New York Times’s “1619 Project.” James McPherson, dean of Civil War historians and another Pulitzer winner, said the Times presented an “unbalanced, one-sided account” that “left most of the history out.” Even more surprising than the criticism from these generally liberal historians was where the interviews appeared: on the World Socialist Web Site, run by the Trotskyist Socialist Equality Party.

The *New York Times*’ 1619 Project is a comprehensive attempt to “reframe [the United States’] history by placing the consequences of slavery and the contributions of black Americans at the very center of [the] national narrative.” Developed in part by journalist Nikole Hannah-Jones, the Project currently consists of a full issue of the *New York Times Magazine*, a podcast series, and a school curriculum. The Project seeks to shape the popular understanding of American political development: America was not “born” on July 4th, 1776; rather, the country’s true birthdate is August of 1619 when African slaves first arrived in colonial Virginia. The Project argues that “nearly everything that has truly made American exceptional,” from its “economic might, its industrial power, its electoral system, diet and popular music, the inequities of its public health and education, its astonishing penchant for violence, its income inequality, the example it sets for the world as a land of freedom and equality, its slang, [and] its legal system” are all grounded, ultimately, in chattel slavery. The Project, thus, attempts to counter the centuries - long whitewashing of American history by flipping the nationalistic brand of American exceptionalism on its head

and ignores the advances put in place by the Civil Rights Act of the 1960's, which prohibits discrimination on the basis of race, color, religion, sex or national origin.

Democrats love to change the definition of words or invent words to advance their Marxist cultural revolutionary movement. Communism, Marxism, Collectivism, Socialism, Social Justice, Identify Politics are all synonymous. Here are more present day examples:

- To be Woke is to be alert to injustice in society, especially racism and sexism.
- Wokeism are personal grievances used as weapons to advance social grievances of racism and sexism, expresses outrage, has no empathy for victims and is a Marxist inspired movement.

Article II, Section 1, Clause 2
