Dear Parents,

As outlined in your program handbook, the Early Head Start / Head Start program at the Childcare Network of Evanston offers several additional services you and your child may be referred to during your enrollment. Please see below for information about each of these additional services:

Health & Developmental Screenings

 Within 45 days of enrollment, CNE staff, or its authorized providers, will conduct screenings to observe and record the health, growth and development of your child. These screenings will occur annually, at minimum, throughout your child's enrollment in the program.

Screening Consent (please initial below)

_____I have been informed about the purpose of screening procedures to identify concerns about health, development, hearing, vision, dental health, behavior, and language, social, cognitive and emotional skills. I give consent for my child to participate in the screening program. Ongoing observation and assessment occurs for the purpose of understanding my child's developmental progress. This information is used to individualize learning goals and plans for my child and will be shared with me.

- If a screening indicates a need for further evaluation, staff will contact parents to discuss the screening results and the
 possibility of a referral. This may include a referral to the State of Illinois' Early Intervention program.
- Health Services
 - Prior to enrollment (time of first services) families must provide CNE with an initial immunization record and a current State of Illinois Certificate of Child Health Examination record completed by a doctor at the last well-child visit.
 - EHS / HS staff can assist families with finding a medical provider.
 - Updated records must be submitted on an ongoing basis as well baby/child visits occur.
- Nutrition Services
 - CNE works with a nutritionist consultant.
 - All meals served at affiliated childcare centers meet the State of Illinois Food program and USDA guidelines for infant, toddler & child nutrition and safety.
 - EHS / HS staff may refer families for direct consultation with the nutritionist as needed.
 - EHS / HS staff regularly consult with the nutritionist to discuss concerns.
- Mental Health
 - CNE has a team of mental health consultants on staff.
 - EHS / HS staff may refer families for direct consultation with the mental health consultants as needed.
 - EHS / HS staff regularly consult with the mental health consultants to discuss concerns.
 - Mental health consultants may directly observe children during group activities and/or at affiliated childcare sites.

I understand and acknowledge that the above services are part of the Early Head Start / Head Start program at the Childcare Network of Evanston.
