

Use your imagination...paint your appreciation!

A mural can be a great activity to involve families and children and creates a great visual for spreading messages of appreciation to ECEs, as well as using our campaign slogans of champions for children, child care champions, decent work and universal child care.

Tips for organizing Mural Painting...

- Materials: Mural paper, paint or marker, glitter...if you dare!
- Cut out a large piece of mural paper. Write or paint a central slogan in very large print on the centre of the mural paper - "Champions for Children", "Child Care Champions" etc. This will anchor the look of the mural and ensure that our main message is seen.
- If you are doing this at a child care, EarlyON centre or FDK, encourage children and parents to contribute to the mural with their own pictures or messages of appreciation. If you are doing this at a college or university encourage both students and faculty to take part.
- Photograph the finished mural and send it to campaigns@childcareontario.org or info.aeceo@gmail.com. We will be collecting and featuring local photos from across the province!
- Share your photos of the mural on social media.
- Display the mural, or consider delivering it to your local MPP or Municipal Councillor's office to show them the support we have from the local community.
