SUMMARY:

Supply Educators support the Early Childhood Educator (ECE) and/or the Assistant ECE in providing nurturing care and developmentally appropriate education to meet the needs of children within a safe and healthy environment in cooperation with colleagues in the absence of customary early childhood educators or assistant early childhood educators.

KEY OBJECTIVES:

- To perform duties in accordance with the mission statement and core values of [name of organization] and the mandate of our Child Care Program.
- To support and assist the ECE's and assistant ECE's in providing a high quality child care program in a group setting that meets the diverse needs and promotes optimum physical, social, cognitive and intellectual development of the children in our care.

DUTIES WILL INCLUDE BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO:

- Meets children's needs for continuance of care, routines and education in the absence of regular caregiver; reassures children as needed; receives instruction from ECE and ECE Assistant to carry out planned activities.
- Implements program plans and helps set up areas for planned activities/learning
 experiences as directed by the ECE or Assistant ECE; provides a welcoming and
 nurturing environment through displaying affection, acceptance and support of each
 child; guides and assists children in activities, routines and transition times; teaches
 appropriate behaviours and skills through modelling, mediating, questioning,
 demonstrating and reinforcing.
- Observes and ensures the safety of the children at all times and advises ECE or ECE Assistant of concerns.
- Attends to the physical needs of children; instructs and assists in washing, dressing, toileting, and eating to develop self-help skills; attends to diapering needs; feeds children and ensures special dietary requirements are met; ensures children are clean, dry and dressed appropriately.

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- Assists in maintaining a healthy and safe environment; reports accidents/ incidents to ECE; observes and reports on illness or health conditions; monitors location for health and safety hazards.
- Greets families and children in a positive manner.
- Other related duties may be assigned by Early Childhood Educator, ECE Assistant or Program Coordinator.
- Works in accordance with Occupational Health and Safety Standards.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Accumulation of at least three months of experience caring for children
- Verbal communication skills
- Clear Vulnerable Sector check current in last 6 months
- Current Standard First Aid and CPR certificate
- Experience working with others in a team environment
- The position requires frequent light to medium physical effort (lifting up to 20 kg or 44 lbs) bending, kneeling, and crouching
- Must be able to work outdoors for at least two (2) hours per day year including during cold, snow, rain, hot and humid weather
