

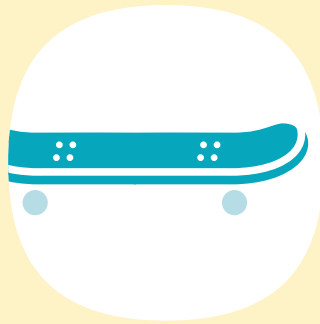

Cool off at the **splash pad** and enjoy lunch from a variety of **food trucks** parked at the beautiful Wilmington Waterfront Park.

NEAR THE HUB:

Port of LA pit stop: The halfway point between Wilmington and San Pedro, the Port of Los Angeles pit stop is the perfect place to stop and take a break. There will be music, food trucks, games, and a rest area. You can also learn more about America's Port by visiting their mobile education exhibit—do you know how many bikes came through the Port of LA last year? Find out here!



PORT OF LA HUB

REI Burbank will be hosting a full service pop-up bike shop and shaded outdoor lounge with a fun slack-lining activity.
