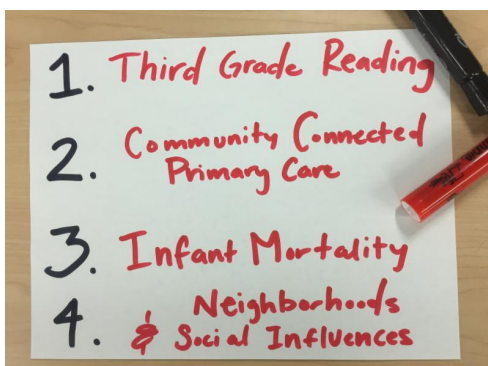


All Children Thrive

First Learning Session

October 2015 – June 2016



On June 14th the All Children Thrive (ACT) network will hold its first learning session. This is the first of many opportunities to share and learn from each other about actions we are taking to be sure All Children Thrive.

Actions include:

1. Improving reading instruction at 4 elementary schools
2. Crossing organizations and disciplines to partner with families around new ways for ACTION planning around all basic needs
3. "Daily Data Text" with obstetric providers and community health workers to be sure rapid connections are made for patients in between clinic visits.
4. Engaging Early Education teachers so that children receive individual, intentional opportunities to learn
5. Integrating mental health services into primary care

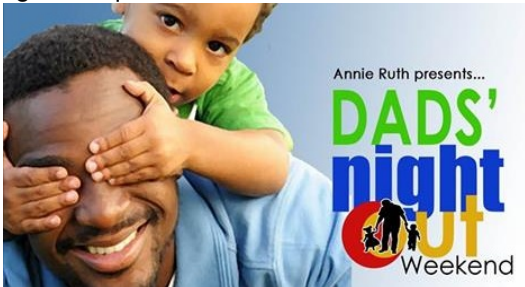
Family Centered Design
