


GOLDEN HILL COMMUNITY GARDEN AND PARK WALK

DISTANCE: APPROX. 1 MILE & 21 MINS

DIFFICULTY: EASY

Route Includes: neighborhood sidewalks, park pathways, and Russ Blvd. alley



- 1** Begin your walk at the corner of 24th and C Street. Head east on C Street towards 25th Street. When you arrive at the corner of C and 25th Street make a left, head north. Enjoy Golden Hill's main street corridor. Continue walking north to the Golden Hill Community Park.
- 2** 25th Street dead ends into the park at Russ Blvd. Continue walking into the park and veer to your right. As you walk northeast, notice the peaceful scenery around you.
- 3** Walk around the park following the path in a loop, along Golden Hill Drive. When you reach the west point of the park before arriving to point 4, make sure to enjoy the beautiful views of downtown.
- 4** Then head south back to the entrance of the park. Walk out of the park heading south and make an immediate right onto the alley, Russ Blvd. Heading west down the alley towards 24th Street, you will see the Golden Hill Community Garden on the right-hand side. The alley will dead end at 24th Street and Russ Blvd.
- 5** Make a left on 24th Street, head south towards A Street. Continue Walking down 24th Street to C Street, where you began your walk.
- 6** End your walk at the mid-block alley of 24th Street in between B and C Street.
