Progress on 15 Intersections Identified in the Pedestrian Safety Performance

Audit

This memorandum is to provide information in advance of the March 6th Council meeting regarding the recently completed Pedestrian Safety Performance Audit. Please find an attached table containing the status of improvements that are being programmed for 15 intersections identified in the Pedestrian Safety Performance Audit. The audit specifically identified these 15 intersections as high pedestrian crash locations that would benefit from pedestrian countdown timers, high visibility crosswalks, and audible pedestrian signals to enhance pedestrian safety. These locations are shown as red markers on Exhibit 9 of the audit report.

It is staff's goal to have these improvements programmed or completed at those 15 intersections by the end of the fiscal year. Staff is also identifying any other additional improvements that will improve pedestrian safety at all of the locations indicated on Exhibit 9 of the audit report.

Two of the intersections, La Jolla Village Drive/I-5 Southbound Off-Ramp and Palm Avenue/6th Street, are under Caltrans jurisdiction. Staff have met with Caltrans to determine the most expeditious way to complete the improvements.
