Spring is here and CLCCA is preparing for the busy summer season!

The annual Community Service Charge also known as the Mill Assessment will be mailed to each property owner within the CLCCA boundary within the next 60 days. Please be sure to pay your assessment by July 31st to avoid late fees. If your mailing address has changed, call the office to update your contact information as soon as possible. CLCCA is not responsible for assessments mailed to the wrong address or being lost in the mail. Therefore, please make sure you receive and pay your assessment by July 31st.

CLCCA Election Day will be held on Saturday, May 7th from 11am-7pm in Room B. Trustee positions open are Oakbrook, Oakbrook West and Camino South. Early voting dates are May 2-May 6, polls open from 11am-7pm. The filing application starts Monday, April 4, 2016 at 8am and the filing deadline submission to appear on the ballot is Friday, April 22nd at 5pm. Form must be returned in person to the CLCCA office or by your agent with a notarized Power of Attorney. Qualifications are listed in the CLCCA Bylaws Article 4.5. Application fee of \$20 is required at the time the application is filed. To receive an absentee ballot, call the Association at 281.488.0360 and ask to speak to the Election Judge or send a letter requesting an "Absentee Ballot" written on the outside of the envelop to the Attn: Election Judge, c/o CLCCA, 16511 Diana Lane, Houston, TX 77062. Your absentee ballot must be received in the mail by Friday, May 6, 2016 in order to be counted. Refer to the CLCCA.ORG website for more details.



#### It's the Law: Houston Department of Health & Human Services <u>Defection by Dogs or Cats</u>

Pet owners must remove all fecal material deposited by their pets on property they do not own, including neighbors' yards, city parks, school property, public rights-of-way, etc.

#### **HPD BIKE PATROLS!**

HPD is doing Bike Patrols for all of Clear Lake City. The Houston Police Clear Lake Division has implemented an overtime program to have HPD Officers who are certified in police bike patrol to ride in the entire Clear Lake (Houston) area. They will be in full police uniform and will be riding black and white police bikes that have HPD decals on them. It is usually during the late mornings to early afternoon and can be any day of the week, they will also be paired up. The Officers will be in constant contact with the Southeast sector dispatch and will be able to respond to citizen concerns if they are close to the call location. Please don't hesitate to call the police if you observe any suspicious persons, vehicles, or activity. What is suspicious activity you ask? Anything YOU think is out of the ordinary! Please don't think you are bothering the police with something trivial, let them investigate to determine if something nefarious is taking place. It is better to be safe than sorry!

## trash COLLECTION...

#### Trashcans should never be in public view before and after trash pick up.

Residents may dispose of their Tree Waste and Junk Waste at their curbside on the second Wednesday of the month. Tree Waste is collected during ODD numbered months and Junk Waste is collected during EVEN numbered months. "Tree Waste" is defined as "clean" wood waste such as tree limbs, branches, and stumps. Lumber, furniture, and treated wood will NOT be accepted. Junk Waste may NOT be placed for collection during a Tree Waste month. Tree Waste months are January, March, May, July, September, and November. "Junk Waste" is defined as items such as furniture, appliances, and other bulky material. Tree Waste is accepted during Junk Waste Months; however, to ensure your Tree Waste is recycled, you may hold your tree waste materials until the next Tree Waste designated month or take it to a Neighborhood Depository/Recycling Center. Junk Waste months are February, April, June, August, October and December. Residents who wish to dispose of Tree Waste or Junk Waste before their scheduled once-per-month collection may call 311.


